### **OUR PARISH**

**THANK YOU, THANK YOU, THANK YOU** to the multitude of volunteers who have come forward to assist with ushering and cleaning, during and following Mass. They are both very big jobs in times like this, and we are so very grateful to you for stepping up. If you would like to join us in keeping the church sanitized or assist with ushering, we ask that you contact the office at 613-547-5004 and leave your name and phone number.

We would also like to thank all the parishioners who have called to reserve seats for the weekend Masses and who follow the many rules that are in place for us to remain open.

We are thrilled that we are finally allowed to open the church for Mass, with government restrictions in place. The following guidelines will be enforced:

- If you exhibit signs of cough, fever, sneezing, or ill health, please stay home and join us celebrating Mass on-line at www.stjosephskingston.ca.

- Masses will be held at 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday, 5:15 p.m. Saturday and 9:00 & 11:00 a.m. on Sunday. Confessions will be available from 4:30-5:00 p.m. on Saturday. The church will open 45 minutes prior to Mass and will be closed immediately following, so that volunteers are able to sanitize for the following Mass. The church will be closed during the day in order to maintain cleanliness for the next Mass. We regret that this has to be done but, in keeping with provincial guidelines, it is a must.

- Please follow directions from ushers for your safety.

- Use hand sanitizer provided at the entrances as you enter and exit the church.

- There will be limited seating available as we enforce a 6 foot (2 metre) distance between non-family members. Call 613-547-5004 or email <u>st.josephs@cogeco.ca</u> Monday-Friday 10:00 a.m.-noon to reserve seating for weekend Masses.

- Seats will be filled from the front of the church to the back, and, after Mass, Communion will be given as you leave the church, starting with the back row. Ushers will direct the entering and exiting of the church.

- At the Sign of Peace, we ask that you simply acknowledge those around you by a nod of the head or a simple smile.

- We ask that you use the washroom only if absolutely necessary, as it is required to be sanitized after each use.

- We have removed hymnals, missals, bulletins and water from the Holy Water Fonts, for your safety.

- If you wish to wear a mask, we ask that it be worn as you enter the church and only taken off to receive Communion, or as you leave. Wearing a mask is encouraged, but not mandatary.

- Collections will not be taken up during Mass; there will be a basket at each entrance for your donations. Thank you for your continued support of St. Joseph's.

- We are extremely happy to be able to offer the Mass in person again, but the safety of our parishioners and clergy is of the utmost importance. Only by following the guidelines set out by our provincial government and the Archdiocese of Kingston can we ensure that this will be met. Thank you for your cooperation.

Please take into consideration that 130+ Masses will need to be rescheduled; and, although all efforts will be made to do so, it may take some time, and the Mass may not be celebrated until 2021. Anyone wishing to request any new Masses may want to consider Unannounced Masses as they are celebrated by retired priests and will be celebrated sooner than newly requested Announced Masses.
