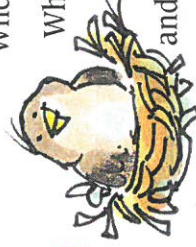

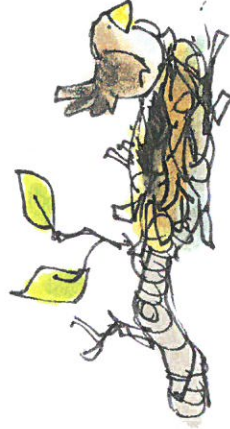
## The Little Sparrow

When you have the flu and you hurt all over

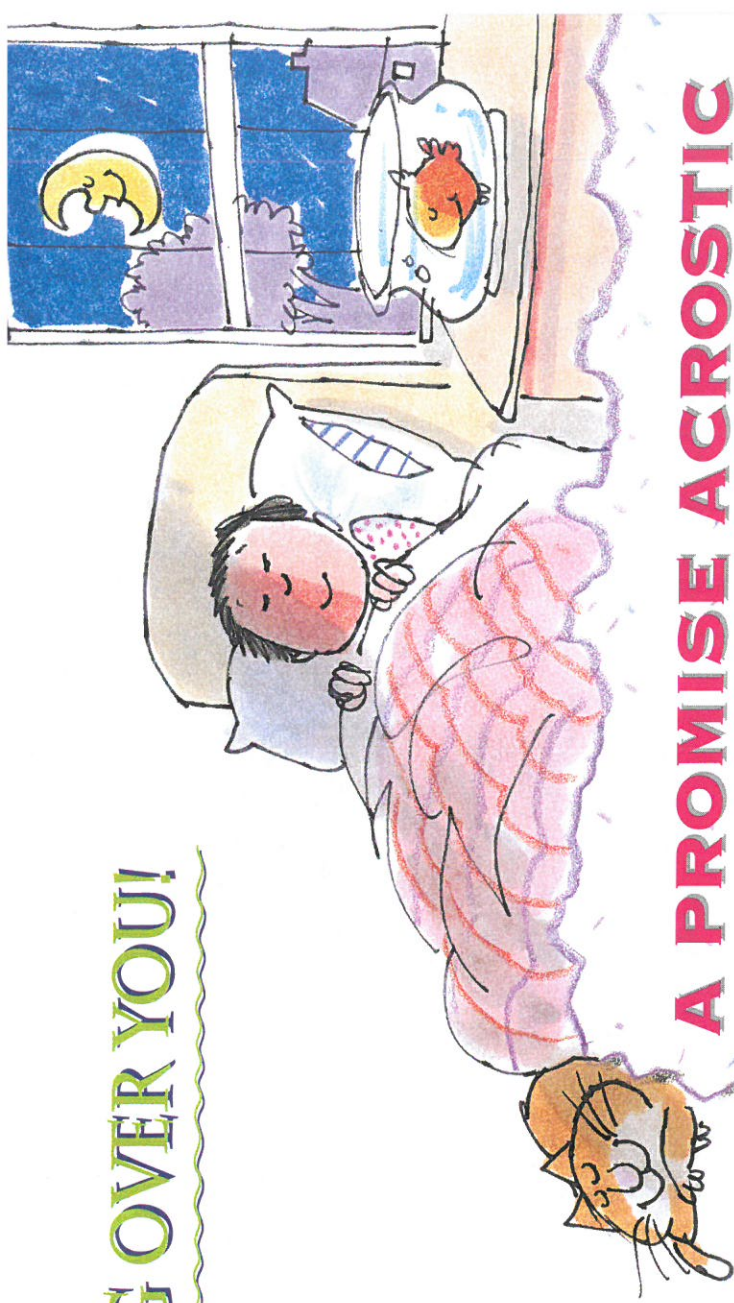
- God is watching over you!

- God is watching over you!

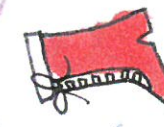
Wherever you go, whatever you do

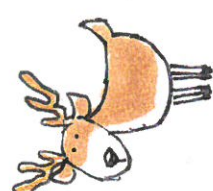


## A PROMISE ACROSTIC
