

### Fr. Cosmas Reflection

# The Power of Small Beginnings

The mustard seed in today's Gospel is described as the smallest of all seeds, yet it grows into a large tree. This illustrates how small, seemingly insignificant acts of faith or goodness can have a tremendous impact over time. It encourages us to value and nurture even the smallest beginnings, trusting in their potential for great growth. The mustard seed represents faith. Even a small amount of faith, like a mustard seed, can lead to remarkable outcomes. This teaches us that faith doesn't need to be grand or perfect to be effective; even the tiniest faith, when genuine, can grow and produce significant results.

The parable also offers us hope and encouragement, especially in moments when our efforts or faith seem minor or insignificant. It reassures us that great things often have humble beginnings and that perseverance and trust in God can lead to profound growth and transformation.

The power of small beginnings is also evident in our relationships. For example, celebrating Father's Day as we do this weekend, we are given the opportunity to think of the men who saw and nurtured our small beginnings. This is a special occasion that celebrates the invaluable role of fathers and father figures in our lives. This day gives us an opportunity to express gratitude, appreciation, and love for the men who have guided, supported, and nurtured us. It's a time to recognize their sacrifices, hard work, and the profound impact they have had on shaping our values and character.

Each gesture of appreciation, big or small, that we show to them, serves as a reminder of the bond shared and the importance of acknowledging their contributions. 


